CLOSING SCHOOL MASS

Our closing school Mass will take place this Friday, June 11 at 8:15 a.m. Student awards and kindergarten diplomas will be presented at this Liturgy. Students should wear their "Sunday best" for this occasion. School will dismiss from church, around 9:45 a.m. Students will not go back to school after Mass.

As we begin our end-of-year celebration for teachers immediately following the closing Mass on Friday, we ask that parents conduct business with teachers on Thursday afternoon or Friday morning before Mass.

The school building will not be open after the Liturgy. Students must be picked up immediately after church. No extended day or supervision is available.

SCHOOL FEES

Just a reminder that diplomas, awards, report cards and transcripts will not be issued until all tuition and school fees for the 2009/10 school year are paid in full and textbooks returned.

Annual, semi-annual and 12-month installment plan tuition payments for 2010-11 are due in June 2010. Invoices will be mailed to parents at the end of this week. Any family wishing to pay tuition and fees by automatic withdrawal or monthly credit card debit MUST COMPLETE A NEW OLV CHECK/CREDIT CARD AUTHORIZATION AND RETURN IT TO SCHOOL BY JUNE 10. WE WILL NOT USE THE ONES ON HAND FROM 2009/10.

Methods of payment for 2010-2011 school fees are the same as this year. Payment options available are:

- check or money order through the mail or turned in at the school office
- credit card payment using Master Card, VISA or American Express may be made in the school office
- credit card payments charged monthly by OLV office to your MasterCard, VISA or AMEX*
- automatic withdrawal (ACH) is available from checking or savings account*

*Enrollment forms are attached for these two types of payment; they will also be mailed with the June statement. **This form needs to be renewed annually;** therefore, please complete and return form to the school office if your elect to use either of these payment methods for the 2010-2011 school year.
