

2009/10 TUITION SCHEDULE

1. RATES

Nursery students will be charged a flat rate of \$8794. These students will not be included in the family total shown for grades Pre-K to Grade 8.

***IN-PARISH:** To be considered for in-parish tuition rates, a family must be registered in Our Lady of Victory Parish for a minimum of one year prior to school registration. In addition, it is expected that those families who claim the in-parish subsidy will attend Mass regularly, participate in parish ministries and activities, and contribute financially to the support of the parish. If this criteria is not met, families will be expected to pay out of parish rates.

2. **DEPOSIT:** A non-refundable deposit of \$1,000 per child is required for all students new to OLV. For students already attending OLV, a \$500 non-refundable deposit is needed to re-register. This fee will be paid directly to Our Lady of Victory School at the time the Tuition Agreement is due.

3. **TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE:** Three methods of payment are available for the tuition balance:

- a. Annual Payment: in full, due on or before June 10, 2009 to Our Lady of Victory School
- b. Semi-Annual Payments: one-half of the total due June 10, 2009 and the second half due by October 10, 2009 to Our Lady of Victory School
- c. Monthly Payments: installments will be made directly to Our Lady of Victory School on the 10th of each month. Two payment plans are available:
 - (1) nine monthly payments from June 2009 - February 2010
 - (2) twelve monthly payments from June 2009 - May 2010

4. NOTES

a. THE SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT to cancel the registration of any student whose family fails to satisfactorily meet tuition payments or late fees (if any) at an Archdiocesan school during the preceding semester or in such cases to require full tuition payment in advance of registration acceptance.

b. THE SCHOOL RESERVES THE RIGHT to withhold a student's school record when the family fails to satisfactorily meet tuition payments, school fees, and/or late fees (if any).

c. PROMPT PAYMENTS: Since the financial obligations of the school are heavy and continuous, families must cooperate in making payments promptly.

d. TUITION PAYMENTS: All tuition payments and school fees are non-refundable.

e. EARLY WITHDRAWAL: Parents who withdraw their child/children for any reason at any time after June 1, 2009 will be responsible for the full financial obligation for the entire academic year.

f. VOLUNTEER SERVICE: All OLV School families are required to contribute \$600 to the Home and School Association or contribute a minimum of 30 hours of volunteer service towards the fund raising activities of the HSA. Families may choose a combination of volunteer hours and financial contributions. Any families with an outstanding balance at the end of the school year will be billed \$20 per hour.

5. HOME AND SCHOOL ACTIVITY FEE: \$125 per family. This fee helps to defray costs of HSA activities (Sock Hop, Bingo Night, Breakfast with Santa, etc).

6. BOOK AND MATERIALS FEES: \$325 per child, nursery through grade 8. Payment is due in full the first week of school.
